Your son/daughter has decided to take Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps as an elective course this year, or perhaps you guided your child toward our program. Whatever the case, your son or daughter is in for a unique experience. Junior ROTC programs are the only courses dedicated to character education. We attempt to achieve this through discipline, community service, self-awareness, patriotism, and leadership training.

We have very **strict dress, classroom, and behavior standards** and we expect our cadets to meet those standards in our classes and in their other classes. Cadets who do not meet the standards can expect to be disenrolled from AFJROTC and placed in another course. During the first week of school we will verbally go over our expectations with each class and also give each new cadet a handbook that explains our standards. Cadets are to keep the handbook and refer to it often. **A test will be given on the handbook after we go over it in class.**

There will be a \$50 AFJROTC fee that includes expenses incurred for the Military Ball, Dining-Out, and Field Day. **The fee is due before the uniform is issued. This fee is non-refundable.** Additionally, we will be sending several forms home with your son/daughter. Please review them carefully, sign, and have them returned the next school day. **Forms and fees must be turned in before the uniform is issued.**

The rewards for taking AFJROTC are many: increased scholarship opportunities, enlistment at higher rank, field trips, orientation flights in USAF and Army aircraft and simulators, the opportunity to compete with a nationally ranked drill team and color guard, and leadership and survival training.

We have a very supportive Parent Booster Club. We encourage you to get involved. There will be a Booster Club meeting scheduled in the near future. Typically they are held in the evenings at school in the JROTC room at 6:30 p.m.
