

Terry Sanford High School Parking Rules 2017-2018

Students, Parents/Guardians: Please read these rules. This must be signed by the student and parent/guardian before the parking permits can be picked up.

- 1) All drivers on school grounds **MUST** recognize that pedestrians have the right of way. Maximum speed on the school campus is 10 mph. Seat belts are mandatory.
- 2) A school parking decal is required on all vehicles located on campus. The cost of a parking permit is \$50.00 to \$75.00 depending on particular lot. The decal is to be hung from the rear view mirror.
- 3) All drivers **MUST** use the area assigned by the school for student parking. Students may park in the teacher's parking lot after 4:00 P.M. Do not park in the teacher's parking lot for any reason before 4:00 P.M.
- 4) Student cars must be locked and will not be visited or moved during the school day unless authorized in writing by school administration.
- 5) Students may not sit in his/her vehicle upon arriving on campus, or loiter in the parking lot. Smoking on campus is not allowed.
- 6) Students illegally parked on school campus (i.e. no decal, under suspension, unauthorized area) will lose their parking permit. You may only park in the space assigned.
- 7) Student is required to show proof of insurance, vehicle registration, and a valid driver's license before an application is approved.
- 8) Giving your decal to another party may result in the loss of your driving privileges for the remainder of the school year.
- 9) Terry Sanford High School or the Cumberland County School System will not be responsible for any loss due to fire, theft, or accident relative to personal vehicles on school grounds.
- 10) Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right. School officials have authority to patrol student parking lots and to inspect the exteriors of student automobiles on school property at all times to maintain safety in the parking lots. The interior of a student's motor vehicle parked on the school premises may be searched if a school official has reasonable grounds for suspecting that the search will turn up evidence that the student has violated or is violating a law or a school rule. (CCS Board Policy Code: 4342 Student Searches)
- 11) Violation of above rules or use of the vehicle to violate any school rules could result in permanent suspension of school parking privileges. First offense may result in a verbal warning. Second and repeated violations of the Parking Rules may result in an automatic loss of parking privileges for a minimum of two (2) weeks. The suspended parking permit will be purchased back for \$10.00.
