Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Fayetteville Terry Sanford High School staff welcomes your child to the 2017 – 2018 school year. We are excited about the possibilities this year holds for your child! Because you may have questions about the start of the school year, the following information is provided for your assistance:

Open House Wednesday, August 23 from 6:00 to 8:00. We will start at 6:00 p.m. in the gym with brief introductions. Homeroom rosters and bus schedules will be posted. This will be an opportunity to find out who will be your child's homeroom teacher and the general location of your child's classes for the coming school year. Schedules will be given to students on Monday, August 28th.

First Day of School: Monday, August 28, 2017...*ALL Students report to their Homeroom to receive their schedule.*

Breakfast and Lunch: Full paying school breakfast will cost .90 and full paying lunch will cost \$2.25 and reduced lunch price is .40. We strongly encourage our students to pre-pay by depositing money into their lunch account. This greatly speeds up students moving through the lines. Students are encouraged to purchase their lunch from school or bring their lunch to school each day. **HOWEVER, DUE TO STATE AND FEDERAL CHILD NUTRITION GUIDELINES FAST FOOD CANNOT BE BROUGHT IN DURING THE SCHOOL DAY TO EAT AT LUNCH.**

School Times: *Students are to be in their scheduled classes by 8:30 a.m.; instructional time begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m.*

Bus Schedule: Bus stops and times will be posted by August 23rd. If you do not see your stop please call or stop by the front office.

Class Schedules: Students will receive their schedule when they report to Homeroom on the first day of school.

Dress Code: Students will be expected to comply with the FTS Dress Code. Dress Code slips will be given to those in violation. Three (3) Slips in a semester will result in a conference with parent and student. Six (6) slips in a semester will result in a call home and one (1) day of ISS. Nine (9) slips in a semester will result in a call home **and** the student will be suspended.

Tardy Policy: Students will be expected to get to class on time within the six (6) minutes allotted for class change. Tardy Slips will be given to those in violation. Three (3) Slips in a semester will result in a conference with parent and student. Six (6) slips in a semester will result in a call home and one (1) day of ISS. Nine (9) slips in a semester will result in a call home **and** the student will be suspended.

10-10 policy: No student will be given a pass out of class during the first ten (10) minutes and the last ten (10) minutes of class.

Book Bags: Students are permitted to carry book bags to and from school. Students are also allowed to carry book bags during the school day and to classes. However, **teachers do have the authority** as to where book bags may be located in the classroom as to ensure the traffic flow and safety of all concerned.

Parking Permits: Permits will be on sale Aug 17th – Seniors Only; Aug 18th – Juniors Only; Aug 21st – Open to All. **Items Needed:** Valid Driver's License, Vehicle Registrations, Insurance Card or Current Insurance Company, and Student Parking Registration Form with a parent signature. Students will be assigned a specific number parking spot in each parking lot. Prices will vary based on lot chosen and will range from \$50 - \$75.

PTA: If you are interested in becoming an officer for the 2017-2018 school year. Please make sure you sign up at the PTA table during Open House. Elections will be held in September.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at the school any time during the next few weeks. Again, with great enthusiasm and high expectations, I look forward to working with you to ensure your child's success at Terry Sanford High School.
